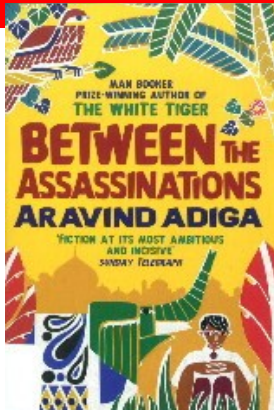


ADIGA, Aravind.— Between the assassinations.—

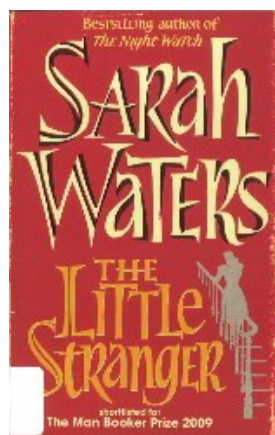
